## Ahmadiyya Chief's Land Facts of Exemption Given

Adverse comments appeared in a section of the Lahore Press, regarding the exemption case of Hazrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmud Ahmad, Khalifatul-Masih II and Head of the Ahmadiyya Community, who along with Ch. Fateh Mahammad Sayal, M.A., jointly owned 49 *kanals*, 11 *marlas*, 105sq.ft. of land in what is known as 134 Acres Scheme, Samanabad, Lahore. A Government hand-out was subsequently published to explain the real facts of the case :

“ The facts of the case are that this land was acquired some years ago, but the two owners did not accept the Land Acquisition Collector's Tribunal. Subsequently, during the pendency of this appeal they approached the Trust for exemption of 2/3rd of their land like other owners, on payment of proportionate development charges on the exempted land. This case was examined in office and it was suggested that, after appropriating 30 per cent of the area towards roads and open spaces, free of cost, the remaining area, measuring 34 *kanals*, 14 *marlas*, ought to be exempted in the form of developed plots on receipt of development charges. This recommendation was on usual lines. As, however, Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmud Ahmad and Ch. Fateh Muhammad Sayal had applied for exemption rather late, and as the necessary area for exemption was not available at this stage, plots measuring in all 18 *kanals*, 5 sq. ft. were exempted on receipt of usual development charges at the rate of Rs. 1,770/8/- per *kanal*.

There was nothing extraordinary about the deal and the case was dealt with on usual lines in the ordinary course.”
